The Learning Centre offers a program that promotes successful transitioning for the students through school-based inclusion, volunteer work placement, community-based experiences, and a food service/domestic skills program. To obtain their 18 credits, Learning Centre students have the opportunity to attend classes within the Learning Centre and the “regular” classrooms under the model of "Inclusive Education". The Learning Centre offers a life skills component that promotes and builds upon independence, wellness, active citizenship, as well as the 18 course credits required to graduate.
