Course: Math 11

Course Description:

This academic course is a 1 credit math course designed to provide students with the opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of math and to acquire the skills required to succeed in Math 12. The course will cover material in Sinusoidal Functions, Trigonometric Equations and Applications, Equations in Three Dimensions, and Statistics.

Math is a demanding subject. Homework will be regularly assigned and must be completed to achieve success in math. If students have finished all assigned questions in class, their homework will be to review the day's work.

Students should have their notebook, graph paper, pencil, straight edge, and a scientific calculator with them at all times. A graphing calculator will be provided for use when one is required.

It is important to note that as a school policy, there will be no make-up tests or assignments due to unexcused absences. Students who miss assessment practices due to an unexcused absence will be given a mark of zero. All work that students are responsible for submitting as well as daily homework will be posted on the homework webpage.
