COMMUNITY-BASED LEARNING 10

Community-Based Learning 10 (CBL 10) is a full-credit or half-credit course designed for grade 10 Options and Opportunities (O₂) students. Students explore the opportunities that businesses and organizations in their community offer and experience through the increased understanding of their employability skills, their personal growth opportunities, and their connection with the community. CBL 10 expands opportunities for students to learn in the community and workplace, providing credit for learning through a range of community-based activities which focus leadership, mentoring, employability skills, and personal growth.

Please note that Community-Based Learning 10 (CBL 10) is part of the Options and Opportunities (O₂) Program and students wishing to take advantage of this program must make application, be interviewed, and be accepted based on criterion set out by the Nova Scotia Department of Education.

As in all education, attendance is of utmost importance and students whose attendance is less than ideal will likely not do well in this course. Evaluation is on-going and based on projects, tests, work experience results, maintenance of a life-portfolio, and success in meeting well-defined milestones.
