Topics covered in this course: Problem solving skills and strategies, Statistics and probability, Relations and functions, Quadratic and linear functions, Operations with polynomials, Exponential functions, Logarithmic functions, Analytic geometry Trigonometry, Sequence and series.

Success in this course is predicated on a minimum of one half hour of homework each day, in addition to classroom time. A provincial exam will be written at the end of the semester; thus, provincial time guidelines must be closely followed.
