

**Math 10 Plus – Communication Plan**  
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**Overview**

Math 10 Plus is a full year academic math program designed to cover the outcomes for the curriculum of Math 10. A passing grade at the end of the first semester (January) will result in an elective credit. **In order to obtain the Math 10 credit, the student must receive a passing grade at the end of the second semester (June).**

The following topics will be studied during the year: patterns and relations, linear equations, statistics, trigonometry, geometry, linear programming, and matrices.

An **unexcused absence** on the day of any test or in-class assignment will result in a mark of zero. Students with excused absences may expect to write a missed test or quiz on the day of their return to class or at the teacher's discretion.

Due dates for assignments / projects are firm. The assignment / project must be sent to the school by the assigned date. A mark of zero will be given to all assignments / projects that have not been handed in by this date. Students will have been given an appropriate amount of time in order to complete the assignment / project.

Students are expected to spend thirty minutes (minimum) on homework and review each evening. All questions assigned during a class are expected to be completed for the next school day. Students are expected to ask questions during class in order to clarify their understanding of each concept. Extra help is available, upon request, during the lunch hour of most school days.
